

Rural Female Labor and Migration in Mexico

Abstract:

The main objective in this article is to analyze the economic participation of rural women in several entities of the country, differentiated by level of migratory intensity. We use a clusters' analysis and the source of data is the National Survey of Occupation and Employment (ENOE, 2010) and the Index of Migratory Intensity for 2010 elaborated by the Consejo Nacional de Población (Conapo). Among the findings, is the information about areas of high migration women that do not have a high participation in agricultural activities, a situation that is common in areas with medium and high migratory intensity such as Guerrero, Oaxaca and Puebla.
