

Latin America: A study object for the social science

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Abstract:

In a general and descriptive way, the main goal of the present text is to show the close relationship between the Latin-American thought and the generation of social science in the region, a particular construct that belongs to Latin America from its imprint and the influence on international politics (in particular, those which are oriented to the development of regional economies).
