

Human Body and Resistance: Between the Flesh and the Reason

Abstract:

The central idea of this article is to think about the body as a kind of node resistance through the sociological observation of its arrangements (according to habits from Bourdieu) and, to think about it in tension with the pleasures that may or may not produce social practices tending to bursting devices of local (disciplines) and global order (biopolitics). The main goal is to think about useless deformation-building of the body (in the sense that Bataille thinks so unproductive in a productive society), to end in a divergent note with Luhmann theory, assuming that only in modernity (liquid, limit, ultimate or post) is conceivable the body as a medium of symbolically generalized communication.
