



CODE OF ETHICS FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND PUBLICATION OF ARTICLES.

Iberoforum, a Social Science Journal edited by the Universidad Iberoamericana

As a guiding principle, Iberoforum, a Social Science Journal adheres to the philosophy and guidelines of the Open Access to Scientific Knowledge.

Iberoforum is an academic journal whose editorial policy supposes an initial review by the Editorial Board and the Publisher in order to verify the correspondence of the article with the journal's criteria of publications. If the article is accepted, the review process itself starts, with a blind academic and independent review by experts on the field. To be published, each article (forwarded to reviewers anonymously) must have two approvals. If the decision is divided, the article should be sent to a third reviewer for its approval or final rejection.

Iberoforum complies with all legal requirements regarding the transfer of rights. In the other hand, each article is deeply review against plagiarism, (assuming that plagiarism is the transcription of the work of another author or by the same author on the occasion of another work, without the recognition of the source in the appointments or in the bibliography).

The final decision - responsible and reasoned and based on the specified criteria of publication Editorial Policy - is awarded to the Publisher and the editorial staff having as primary mission to preserve academic quality. It is important to note that the research themes are free and the choice of authors, that there is no censorship in any subject, and that opinions are the responsibility of the authors that emit them. Primary research where the researcher agrees with the author are prioritized, but theoretical studies with comprehensive review of bibliography and multiple sources are also supported.

Finally, to complete the editing process, all articles are subjected to a review of style to ensure the quality of its writing and are published only after the cession of the copyrights and their claim that it is an unpublished article not published previously.

In principle, once published, articles cannot be varied or be removed from the website of the magazine. However, in exceptional cases, to cause that justifies it, an article may be modified or withdrawn. If an article was accepted and not yet published, the author can remove it, justifying the reasons for that decision in a signed note addressed to Council of Edition of the journal. In the case of published articles, the causes of removal must be serious: clear mistakes that threaten the quality of the article, which is not an unpublished article despite statements by the author, that there are legal claims of other authors, infringes any law or be checked plagiarism not detected previously.
